



# Blockchain for Good: The Untold Story Leading from the UN to AXIS

From MDGs to grassroots communities — In the early 2000s, the Millennium Development Goals and the Sport for Development and Peace movement opened up a new line of thinking: how to sustainably finance the infrastructure needed for local development in Africa?

The African paradox — Despite an abundance of natural resources, African states continue to rely heavily on external funding to build schools, health centers, sports facilities, and other public amenities. This contradiction is impossible to ignore.

Bangui 2012: The Foundational Question — During discussions with former Central African Prime Minister Élie Doté, an idea took shape: how to finance Africa with its own resources? This reflection would give rise to PPV and then PPV2RN.

From PPV2RN to WinstantGold — The convergence of natural resource development, economic sovereignty, and digital technologies gradually led to the creation of WinstantGold, now a pilot project of the national AXIS program in the DRC.
